16-Jul	<b>E.T.: The Extra-Terrestrial</b>	See one of the greatest family classics of all time on the big screen, as it was meant to be seen. The story of a loveable alien who is stranded on Earth and is protected by children until he finds his connection home again. A piece of movie magic that touches hearts both young and old, with a 98% approval rating on the Rotten Tomatoes website. Musical performance by Jill Jambor, a recent Summerfolk Discovery with a "sweet new-folk voice" and stellar songwriting who has already shared stages with Suzie Vinnick and Dala, among others.
23-Jul	<b>The Secret of NIMH</b>	To save her ill son, a field mouse must seek the aid of a colony of super-intelligent rats, with whom she has a deeper link than she ever suspected. The film garnered critical acclaim for being one of the most vibrantly animated films of all time and has earned a 94% approval rating on the Rotten Tomatoes website. Musical performance by Jonathan Farmer, a highlight from the 2009 series whose rapport with kids will have them up playing and dancing before the movie starts.
30-Jul	<b>Babe</b>	A piglet won by Farmer Hoggett as a raffle prize is raised by Fly, the matriarch sheepdog, as one of her own. His owner senses something special in Babe and makes sure he learns sheep herding along with his new brothers. Babe proves so adept, in fact, that Farmer Hoggett enters him in the world sheepdog championship. An all-time family classic, with a 98% approval rating on the Rotten Tomatoes website. Musical performance by Kildear, a young Owen Sound female duo whose quirky lyrics, sweet harmonies and “acousmatic” sound are putting them on the fast track to recognition and acclaim.
6-Aug	<b>Silent Film Night feat. Charlie Chaplin in "City Lights"</b>	City Lights is considered by many to be the greatest of all Charlie Chaplin's films. A tramp (Chaplin) meets a young and beautiful girl selling flowers on the street and learns that a costly operation could give her sight. Through a series of comedic twists and turns, the tramp attempts to win the money for the operation and the love of the beautiful flower girl. On this very special evening, Owen Sound's own Silent Film Ensemble accompanies the film with an original score. The Silent Film Ensemble provides original live, post-modern soundtracks to films of the Silent Era using varied instrumentation, including: harp, banjo, violin, home-made instruments and synthesizers.
